Elders and Pastors – Suspending All Large Gatherings thru the End of March. Based on the anticipated exponential spread of the Covid-19 in the US and at the request of the President of the United States, your leaders are suspending all large gatherings (over 10 people) through the end of this month. The recommendations are clear that person to person contact must be limited in the near future and we are abiding by that official request which is consistent with the Great Commandment to “love your neighbor as yourself.”

Updates. Please know your Elders and Pastors are meeting weekly, and more frequently if necessary, to maximize how we care for our congregation and meet your needs during this time. Periodic updates will be provided through email and posted on our website at cc.today, along with the current status of various events.

Sunday Services will be Provided Online. Live broadcasts will stream the full service at 9:00 and 10:30 every Sunday morning with on-demand opportunities available at any time following. Connection Groups are encouraged to watch the service online and then discuss and share either in-person or electronically.

Connection Groups are the Key to Staying Connected. Please stay connected through your connection group. If your gathering is 10 or less persons who are not “at risk,” you may choose to meet in a home or perhaps on the church campus. Also, electronic communication is a great way to stay connected through platforms like Google Hangouts, Zoom, Facetime and Facebook Live.

Help is Available. If your income is adversely affected during this time, the church is willing to help as funds are available. Also, let’s work together as Ministry Partners in reaching out to our neighbors.

Faithful Giving is Necessary. During this time when the church has many opportunities to show compassion, both within the church family and in the community, it is more important than ever that we remain faithful.
